

Sheet 1.1: Where should the carrots be planted? Briefing sheet

The farming co-operative are looking for new sites to plant carrots. They would like you to recommend one or more suitable locations where carrots can be grown successfully. Try to choose a site close to where you live.

You will need to find out:

- the ideal soil type for carrots to grow successfully
- the ideal climate conditions
- the soil type and climate conditions (including temperature, rainfall and frost days) of your chosen location.

The co-operative would like you to prepare a short report or presentation which covers the following points.

- The information you have found.
- The location of the site or sites that you've chosen.
- The climate and soil conditions of the chosen site or sites.
- The reliability of the information you've found.
